SARGAM 2025, a National Level Intercollegiate Cultural Fest based on the theme “Operation Sindoor,” was inaugurated on 15th November 2025 by Dr. Mohan Manghnani, Honorable Chairman, New Horizon Educational Institutions, along with the Chief Guest and Guests of Honour. The fest saw participation from more than 10,000 students representing 365 colleges across the country.

RAM MANDIR FLAG HOISTING



A historic flag hoisting ceremony, known as Dhwajrohan, was held on 25 November 2025 at the Ram Mandir in Ayodhya, marking the formal completion of the temple construction. The event was attended by religious leaders, temple trust members, and national dignitaries.

During the ceremony, a sacred saffron "Dharma Dhvaj" (religious flag) was hoisted atop the temple's main spire. 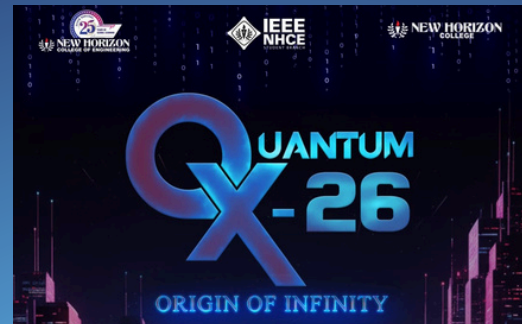
