### **Key Summary**

Key successes included squad patrols, the awareness session, zero incidents, and team collaboration, meeting UGC/AICTE standards.

#### **1. Submission of report**

Committee members discussed and decided that the Anti-Ragging Squad must submit weekly reports on freshers under their supervision to ensure ongoing monitoring of student interactions. The Convener informed all members that it is mandatory for all students to fill out the Anti-Ragging Undertaking, download it as per UGC guidelines, and submit compliance reports without fail. Further he congratulated the Squad members for their efforts in keeping the campus ragging-free.

#### **2. To take decision on vigilance rounds**



Committee members emphasized the squad's duty to maintain vigil across high-risk areas such as hostels, canteens, classrooms, grounds, and entry points. They highlighted the need for mobile, surprise inspections to prevent ragging incidents proactively. Squads must report any observations immediately to the nodal officer
