Round 1: Unlock the Gate

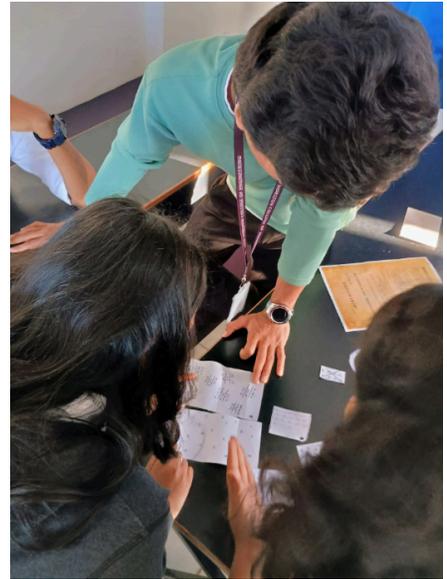

The team that cracked the code the fastest emerged victorious. The round showcased not just logical skills, but also the ability to work effectively under tight time constraints, making it an exhilarating finale.
