### Session 2 – UI Design with Java Swing

His hands-on approach helped students grasp how Swing can be used to enhance interactivity and usability in Java applications.






How would you rate Session 1 (Talend Open Studio)?




How would you rate Session 2 (UI Design for Java App)?




