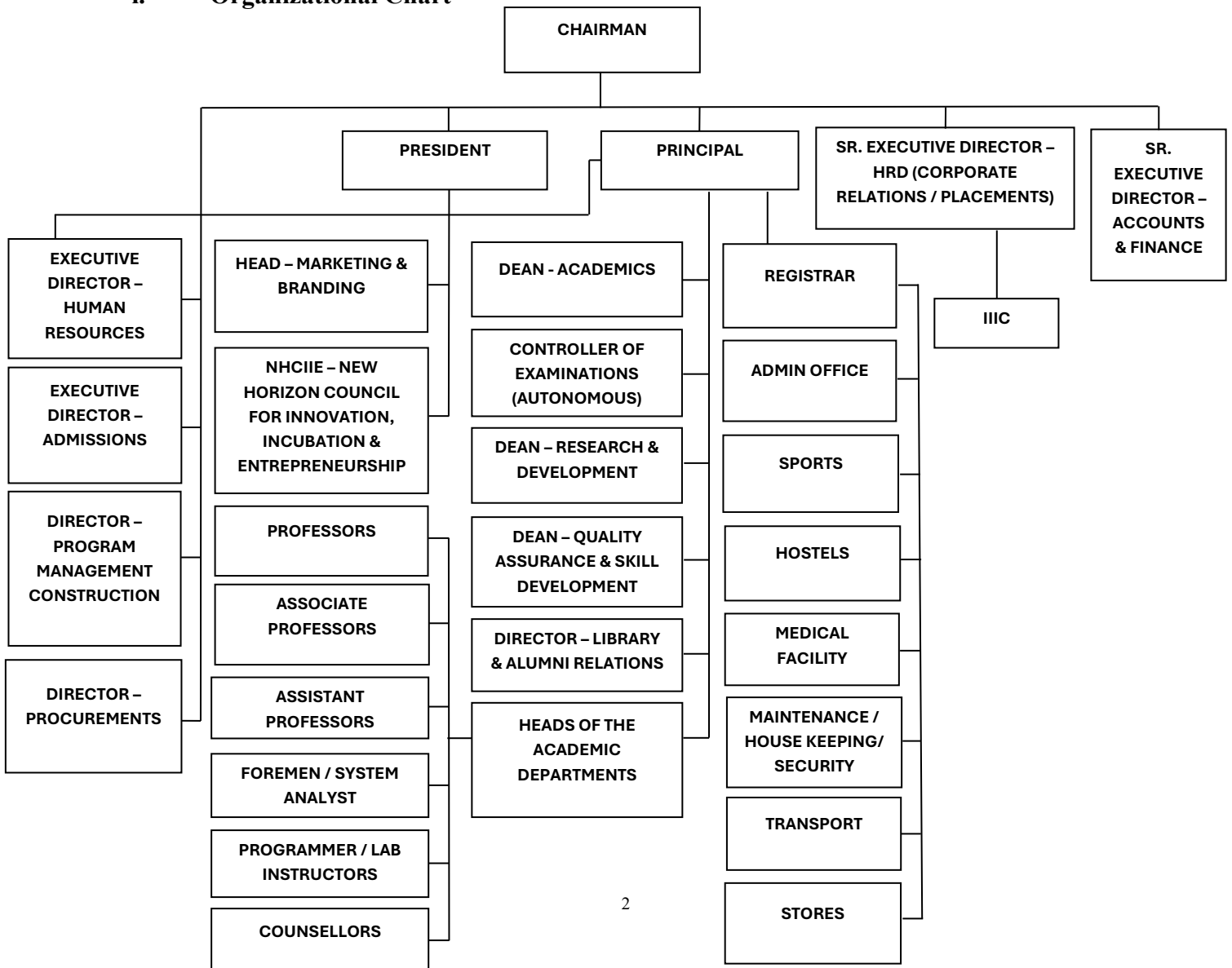

#### Admission Committee:

An Admission Committee consists of Heads of the Institution, who represent direct Management, responsible for evaluating applications and making final decisions on which candidates will be offered admission to a specific academic program. Their key functions include establishing admission criteria, evaluating applications, ensuring the process is fair and transparent manner. Beyond academics, committee aims to build a well-rounded and diverse students who bring varied talents, perspectives to the Institution.

By diligently reviewing applications and adhering to established policies, the committee helps maintain the credibility, trustworthiness, and reputation of the institution's admission procedures.

#### Seat Sharing:

##### BE:

It is stipulated that, the counselling by KEA shall be conducted as per the calendar of events, prescribed by the regulating authorities – AICTE/ UGC/ Affiliating Universities respectively. It is predetermined that, if any seats remain unfilled/ vacant after end of all rounds of counselling by KEA, the balance seats would revert to the Association / Institution for its appropriate allotment or being filled by the respective colleges. The reversion of seats would happen after reconciliation with KEA.

New Horizon College of Engineering, being a member of KRLMPCA (Karnataka Religious and Linguistic Minority Professional Colleges' Association) hand over 40% of seats out of the total intake available to Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA), for counselling and allocation of seats

under Government, based on merit as per ranking to be determined/ assigned by the Government (KEA).

Out of total intake 30% of seats in each of the KRLMPCA member Engineering Colleges shall be filled by candidates through KRLMPCA conducted entrance test followed by centralized counselling. In case any of the KRLMPCA Member Engineering Colleges desire to have their 30% or less intake of seats to be filled through KEA, they can surrender the seats to KEA before first round of counselling.

The remaining 30% of the total intake of seats will be filled up by Management, based on merit and entrance exam by notifying the method of filling up of the seats in the website. In case any of the College desire to have their 30% or less intake of seats to be filled through KEA, they can surrender the seats to KEA before first round of counselling.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

The student should have passed 2nd PUC/ 12th standard with English as one of the languages and obtain a minimum of 45% of marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with Chemistry / Computer Science/ Electronics/ Biology. In case of SC, ST and OBC candidates, the minimum aggregate percentage shall be 40%.

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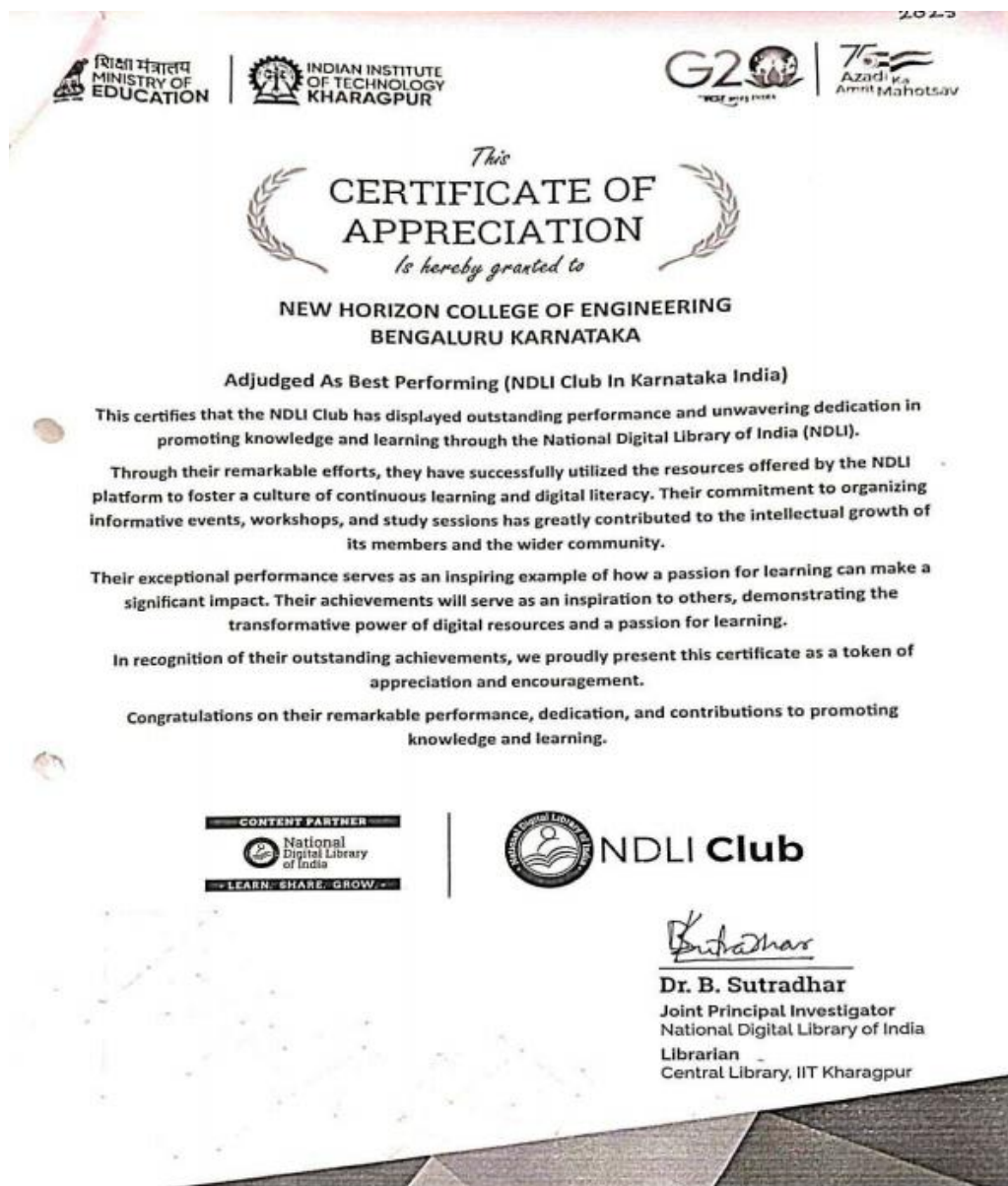
