



A Report on Shradhanjali and Prarthna Ceremony

New Horizon College of Engineering solemnly organized a *Shradhanjali and Prarthna* ceremony to pay tribute to the innocent lives lost in the tragic Pahalgam incident of 2025. The event was conducted on 22nd April 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the Open Stage, with the entire college community coming together in unity and grief.

The program commenced with all students, faculty, and staff assembling at the venue by 3:50 p.m., maintaining discipline and silence to honor the occasion. The ceremony began with a brief narration recounting the tragic events of 22nd April 2025, where 26 innocent civilians lost their lives and 20 others were injured in the unfortunate attack at Pahalgam. The narration highlighted the pain and loss experienced by the nation and emphasized the importance of unity during such times. Following this, a short address reflected on India's strong response to the tragedy and the nation's resolve against such acts of violence. The words of Shri. Narendra Modi ji were recalled, reaffirming the country's stance: "*We will not forget, and we will not forgive.*" This message instilled a sense of patriotism and solidarity among the audience.

A one-minute silence was observed to pay homage to the departed souls, creating a deeply emotional and respectful atmosphere across the gathering. This was followed by a soulful music performance, which added a reflective and calming dimension to the tribute. The ceremony continued with candle lighting, where students and faculty lit candles as a symbol of remembrance, peace, and hope. The glowing candles stood as a powerful representation of collective mourning and resilience.

The event concluded with the National Anthem, bringing the gathering together in a spirit of unity, patriotism, and respect for the nation.

The Shradhanjali and Prarthna ceremony served as a meaningful initiative by New Horizon College of Engineering to honor the victims, express solidarity with their families, and reinforce the values of peace, unity, and national integrity among students and staff.
