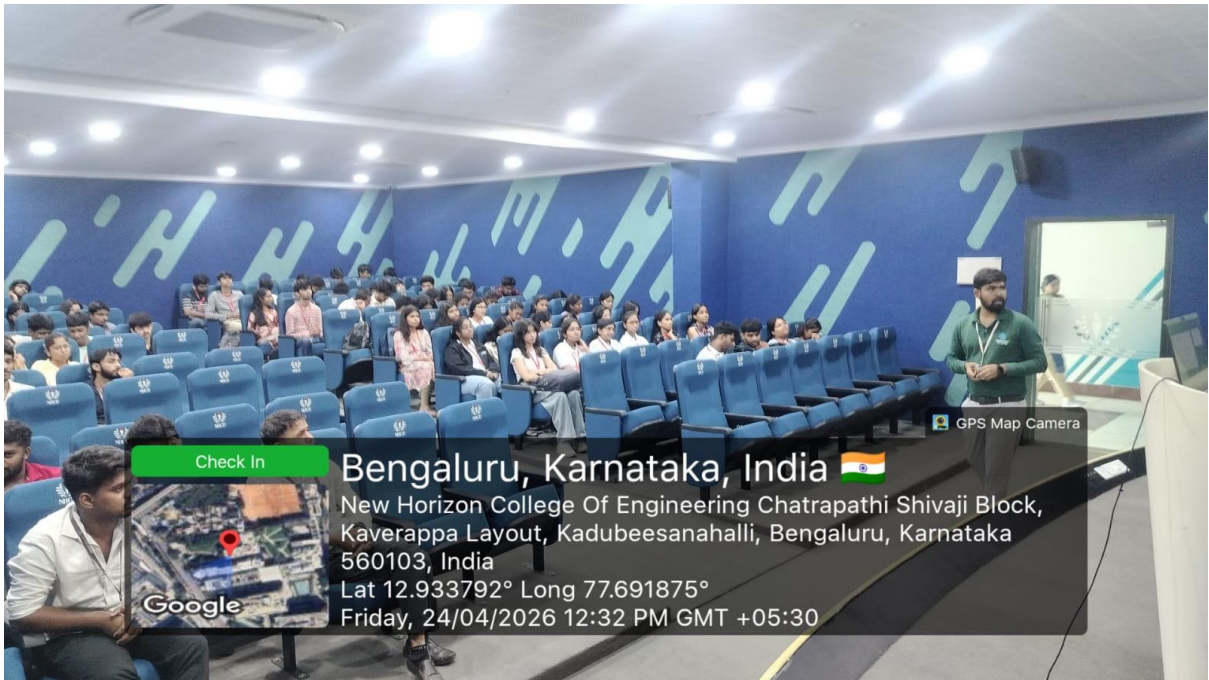

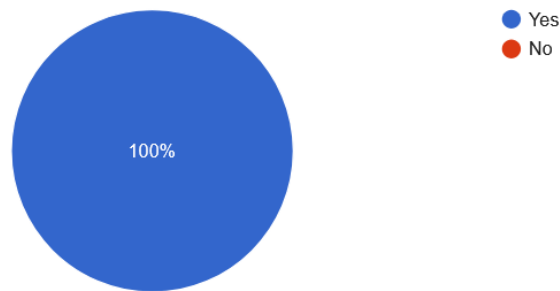

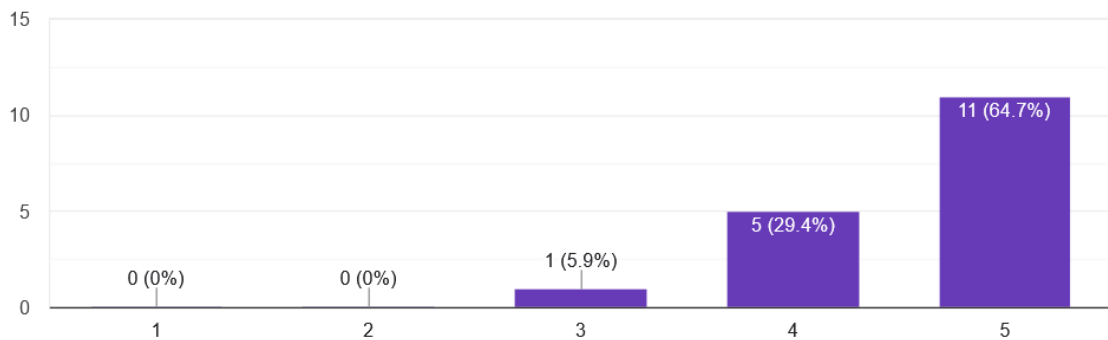

How clearly did the speaker communicate their key messages?

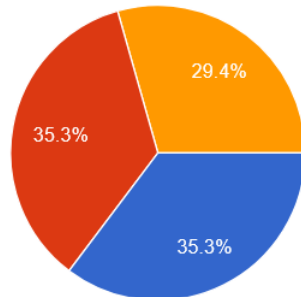

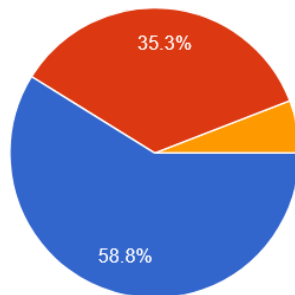

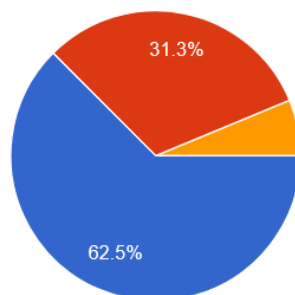

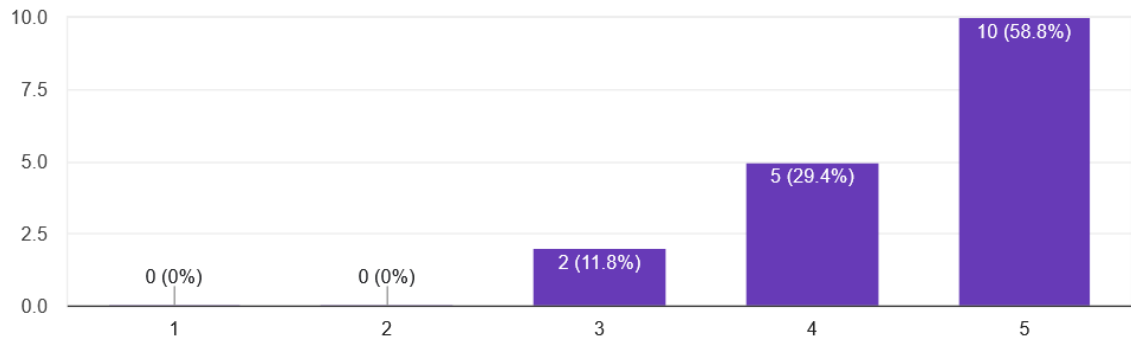
