






Motivational Talk

- Simple ways to stay positive








4-DAYS ONLINE HANDS-ON WORKSHOP USING MATLAB & SIMULINK- RESEARCH PERSPECTIVE

SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT "OPPORTUNITIES & CHALLENGES"






"PERSONAL BRANDING & BEING PROACTIVE"

5 DAYS INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON "CROSSING BARRIERS IN RESEARCH




MOTIVATIONAL TALK ON "EMBRACING CHANGE IN YOU DURING COVID-19"






One Day National Conference on




