Topics covered in the Training:

- Basics of Networking (Network types, Topologies Protocols etc.)
- IP Addressing and Subnetting
- Switch and Router configuration and commands
- LAN installation with switch
- LAN installation without/with router
- WAN Installation

Summary:

The training mainly focused on the two important paradigms of computer networks Viz., OSI-ISO reference model and TCP/IP Architecture. A brief introduction on the various protocols and the networking elements over each layer was given. Some insight on the types of networks i.e. LAN, WAN and MAN, topologies like Bus, Star, Ring, Hybrid topology was demonstrated. Two protocol versions (IPV4 and IPV6) and their addressing schemes (different class of addressing: Classful and Classless), subnetmask, subnetting, some practical examples related subnetting was also discussed.

The steps for configuring a simple LAN and WAN network were demonstrated. The steps for configuration a workstation to access internet automatically (using DHCP) and manually was shown. The architecture of the switch and Router, their functionalities and how they are configured in LAN network was briefed. Few router commands and Switch commands for basic configuration were discussed.

On whole the session was interactive and few doubts raised by the instructors related to IP addressing, Subnetting and LAN configuration were addressed.







The program went as follows;



Report on PDP master training-CSE

Mural is easy to use and intuitive. It didn't take long to learn how to use it. Also, templates are really handy - it's so much easier to start with new online interaction tool.

I like to be able to walk up to a whiteboard and sketch out ideas as which was discusses with my colleagues. With students and teachers are being remote these days, this gives a way for better interaction.

The best way to share with specific people seems to be to send them a link, but in terms of sharing for a wide audience, It's not always straightforward to export the mural itself into a report or another document. I usually have to take a screenshot, which can't always capture everything going on within the mural in question because I have to zoom out so much to capture everything.

Mentimeter helps to solve the problem of always calling on the same students by getting feedback from the entire class. It gives a way with a whole class poll to gauge mood or ask an essential question.

Dynamic presentations give all students a voice, assess understanding of concepts, provide instant feedback, and create opportunities to ask questions.

The limitation I found is that it is not supporting for a greater number of presentations. Next, it is allowing to create limited quiz questions. Other than these two limitations it is good for interaction but the same time all concepts have to be covered as per lesson plan. So, it shall be used in one class per module is pretty good.

I would like to thank Quality Assessment and Skill Development Center for arranging this master training and gave an opportunity to learn about the new online interactive presentation tools like Mural and Mentimeter.



Report on one day FDP on "Practical skill enablement"

The Department of Information science and engineering in association with the Department of Quality Assessment and Skill Development Center (QASDC) has conducted one day FDP on "Practical skill enablement" for lab faculty on 28/10/20 from 9.30am to 4.30pm. Training included the sossions on Data Structures, Python programming, VMWare and Digital logic design laboratories.

1st Session at 9.30 on Data Structures laboratory was handled by Mrs. Karthiyayini J, Sr. Asst. Professor, Dept of ISE. The training started with the basic definition related to Data structures and also discussed different types of data structures. Training covered the basic syntax of C programming and explanations of lab programs were given and discussed about the syntax Lab staff interacted well and they executed a few lab programs. Discussed about the debugging process and kinds of errors that occur during compilation and execution.


2nd session at 11.30 on python programming laboratory, was handled by Mrs. K M Bilvika, Asst. Professor, Dept of ISE. The training covered introduction to python, basics and syntax of python programming and explanation of lab programs. Lab faculty were trained practically on python programs including creating new python files, coding with python and execution of the programs. They were also given the opportunity to code and execute programs on their own. Lab programs were explained and demonstration was given for the same, later lab faculty have executed the lab programs and were able to identify the types of errors that can occur and to debug the errors.

3rd session at 1.30pm on VMWare laboratory was handled by Mrs. Shoba S, Sr. Asst. Professor, Dept of ISE. Session included an overview of virtualization was given with basic introduction of vmware virtualization essentials. Gave a brief discussion on the vmware HOL 2011 lab console.

In the session, all the lab instructors were made to register in VMware HOL and a hands-or was conducted with parallel demo on the following :-

- 1. Creation of virtual machine.
- 2. CPU and Memory Hot Plugs
- 3. Disk provisioning techniques
- 4. Limiting remote sessions
- 5. Migrating virtual machines

4th session at 3.00pm on Digital logic design laboratory was handled by Mrs. Rafega Beham, Sr. Asst. Professor, Dept of ISE. The training started with binary number system representation. Then, concept of basic gates were introduced. The logical diagram, Expression and Truth table of each basic gates were discussed. Following that, the Sum of product expression and also the different combinational circuits used to implement the SOP expression were explained to them. The multiplexer circuit was discussed in detail to implement SOP expression. A real time problem statement is considered and the truth table and implementation for the same is designed with 8:1 Multiplexer circuit. Then, the circuit connections were carried out using the Digital Trainer Kit and the truth table was verified.

Training concluded at 4.30 and all the lab faculty had an opportunity to understand the lab programs, common errors that occur during execution of experiments and to debug the common syntax errors.




Thereafter the trainer involved the participants in various kinds of activities like Role plays, games and group discussion to construct their own knowledge on Interpersonal skills and communication skills.



The topics covered were:



Profile of the Speaker:

He is the author of *Behind the Silicon Mask, Bangalored: the Expat Story, God Save the Toddy, Age-old Tales* and *Wiser After.* As a freelance journalist, he contributed to media agencies in India, Pakistan and Singapore. He was chosen as a Fellow of the Asia Journalism Fellowship in 2009. He conducts training programs in corporate houses, educational institutions, the army and the Air force as well as government companies. As a part of Faith Foundation, he designed and implemented programs to eradicate child sex abuse from the society. It has reached more than 55000 children in India and abroad. Objectives:

Content:


Outcomes:
