

## RENEWABLE & NON-RENEWABLE ENERGY GENERATION AND POLLUTION CONTROL






#### **INTRODUCTION TO AWS EC2 AND S3**

The parents and guardians responded splendidly to the simulated activities, and enjoyed every moment of the session.




#### DR.SOWMYA NARAYANAN'S WEBINAR ON "SKILLS FOR WORK AND LIFE"

Decision of the jury was considered final.




### **WORLD ENTREPRENEURS DAY CHARCHA**
