Shreyas R , Shashidhar, Rajarshee Chatterjee.






INDUCTION TRAINING FOR THE I YEAR MBA STUDENTS


LEADERSHIP LANEWAY: HERALDING A NEW ERA OF MINDFUL CORPORATES


The main motive of the session was to bring insights and educating the students on:

REFRAMING CO'S & PO'S IN ALIGNMENT WITH NEP 2020

The Department of NHQASDC, NHCE organized a Faculty Development program on Reframing CO's & PO's in alignment with NEP 2020 on 28th September 2021. The external speaker for this event was Dr. Anala, Professor, Department of Information Science and Engineering, RV College of Engineering, Bengaluru. Faculty members of MCA Department attended this workshop.

The resource person initiated the session with the importance of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and how to achieve the OBE through various programs. The expert highlighted the importance of Assessment, Evaluation techniques, and how to deliver the content and the continuous improvement to achieve the CO-PO attainment. Dr. Anala threw light on Program Educational Objective (PEO) and mentioned that a department can easily get identified from the PEOs. She gave an insight on Programme Outcomes (PO's) which are defined by National Board of Accreditation (NBA), Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs) which are defined by the respective department and Course Outcomes (COs) which are more specific to a particular course. She also highlighted that minimum number of COs to be set for each module.

She highlighted that minimum two courses should address POs and how Bloom's Taxonomy levels should be aligned with the PO's. She also mentioned about Program Specific Criteria (PSC) and how it

changes from time to time. She shared her audit experiences in various institutions and what needs to be avoided while mapping CO's with PO's. She explained how to map CO' and PO's with examples too.

Further, she delivered a thorough discussion on how to make the rubrics for lab paper, project evaluation, mini-project etc..., in detail which included the creation of the Course Articulation Matrix (CAM) and Program Articulation Matrix (PAM) in detail.

The session was very interactive and informative and all faculty enjoyed the session.
