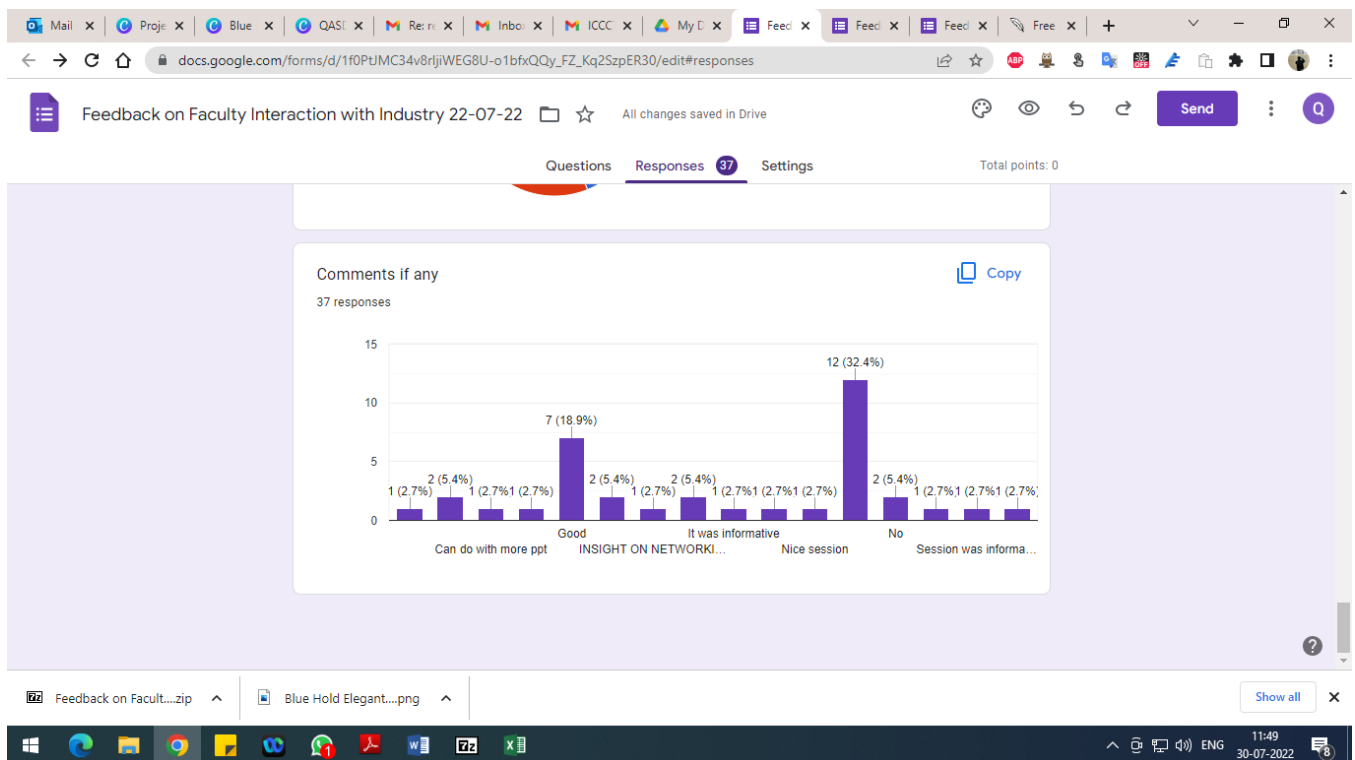
Finally, Dr. Rajesh G, (Associate Professor ECE and Coordinator of the event) delivered vote-of thanks and winded up the session by 4:15PM.
