Topic : Navigating through Adolescence and Young Adulthood


Resource person : Mrs. Deepthi Kodoth, Consultant Counsellor

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
Session Summary:

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The resource person discussed about the distinctive features of emerging adulthood such as identity explorations, instability, self-focus and feeling in-between adolescence and adulthood. Mrs. Kodoth focused on identifying and dealing with common mental heath challenges during this transition. She also discussed about peer pressure, stress, addictions, pornography and problematic internet usage. The speaker emphasized on importance of seeking help during this challenging phase and also educated about different mental health professionals.
