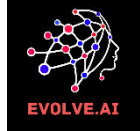

Event Description:

The Evolve.AI club conducted an event called 'MIND LABS' which was an open-invitation technical event consisting of two rounds. The basis of the event was knowledge of important technology terminology, basic coding skills, and display of problem-solving ability. The premise behind conducting this event was to showcase the importance of building logical thinking skills and understanding the lingo that is used on a daily basis in the technical world.



ROUND 1:

The first round, called Uptop, consisted of a game in which, out of a team of two, one of them has to hold a phone which displays a word that the other person has to describe to them with their prior knowledge on the subject, of course without the use of aforementioned word. The members of the club designed a web application for the conduction of this event that displays the word the players are supposed to guess and they can tap the green side of the screen when they get it right, and the red side if they wish to skip the word. A point is given for every word they guess correctly and the team standings for the first round were based on that. The top 6 teams (12 participants) moved on to the second round.



ROUND 2:

The second round, called Code-a-phrase, had ten questions which the participants had to solve to win. The questions consisted of code debugging, decrypting cyphers, and other technical challenges to overcome. The club team made three different sets of questions from which one question was passed out at a time.

Once they solve it, they are given the next question to proceed. Each participant is allowed a preset number of hints, which they can ask the club members whenever they need it. The first three to finish solving all their questions place in first, second, and third respectively as the winners.
