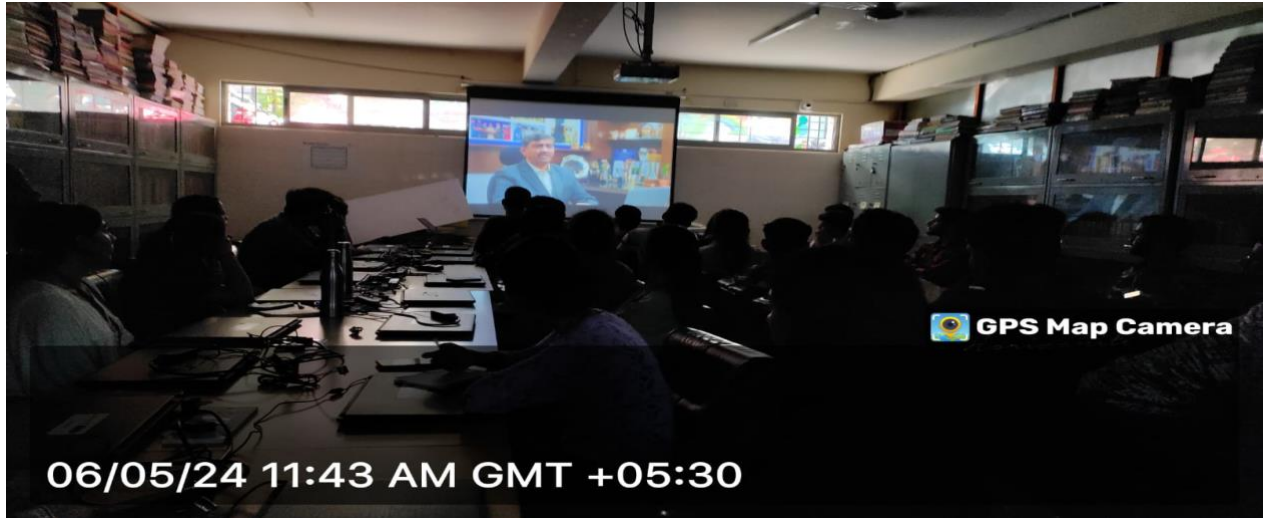
Targeted Audience: Students from EEE, CSE, ISE, CE,AIML,CIVIL,Mech students and Faculty members
