- The management can also nominate faculty members who need to improve, irrespective of their experience and based on the recommendations of NHQASDC, post classroom teaching observations carried out regularly.
- NHQASDC will continuously monitor the faculty members in this regard
- The registration fees for the above said course has to be taken care of by the management as a token of encouragement
