Every individual, whether an adult or a child, deserves to live with basic essentials and facilities, and this is what we aim to provide through this camp.

The community service camp was for conducted for a day on **02/02/2024**. It was a 5-hour long drive from our college campus to the **Heggadadevankote (Mysuru)**.

I. ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED DURING THE CAMP

Our team visited two tribal hamlets, with the first village housing a total of 40 families from the Betta Kuruba Tribe. Our primary focus was on supplying essential items such as mats, buckets, jugs, plates, and clothing. A meeting was arranged with the community, during which our team engaged in discussions about their life experiences, challenges, and aspirations. We shared thoughts on how we could contribute to improving their community and collectively make a positive impact.

In the second village, which housed a total of 80 families belonging to the Jenu Kuruba Tribe, we extended the same essential amenities – mats, buckets, jugs, plates, and clothing. During discussions with the villagers, we compiled a list of their concerns and problems.
