A REPORT ON EYECON

The NHCE Leo Club, in collaboration with Devi Eye Care, hosted the 'EyeCon' event at New Horizon College of Engineering on 20th March 2025. This initiative aimed to promote awareness about eye health among students, provide free eye check-ups, and support those in need of further medical assistance. With over 270 students actively participating, the event successfully emphasized the importance of vision care and preventive eye health among young individuals.

The event was held in the college library, offering a comfortable and professional setting for consultations. A team of experienced ophthalmologists and optometrists from Devi Eye Care conducted the check-ups using advanced medical equipment. To maximize the effectiveness of the event, the following activities were conducted:
