

A REPORT ON INITIUM 2025

The grand inauguration of INITIUM 2025, NHCE's flagship intercollegiate literary fest which was held on 16th May 2025, commenced with an air of enthusiasm and creativity. With the theme, "Wizarding World", this year's edition marked a celebration of ideas, innovation, and student spirit. The soulful invocation song was rendered by Ms. Aradya S. V., a 6th-semester student from the ISE Department, followed by the Lighting of the Lamp by the dignitaries.

The Former President of the Literary Club, Ms. Fatima Zehra, delivered an inspiring alumni address, reflecting on her journey and the legacy of INITIUM. Her words resonated deeply with the audience, especially the student community. The ceremony continued with a graceful solo dance performance by Ms. Nikitha R., a 4th-semester student of the CSE Department, encapsulating the spirit of expression and creativity that INITIUM represents. Dr. Manjunatha, Principal-NHCE, officially declared INITIUM 2025 open, which was the event's high point. The National Anthem played to close out the celebration.

The following events were conducted during INITIUM.

- **1.Monochromancy:** Participants showcased their artistic skills by creating artwork using a single color, experimenting with shades to depict the Magic and Wizarding World theme. Without using any reference images, they demonstrated exceptional creativity and skill, producing unique pieces that reflected their interpretation of the theme.
